We have taken action on:

Housing benefit cuts – if your benefit has been cut and you can't pay your rent, your landlord may decide to evict you. We can support you to resist eviction and put pressure on landlords to reduce rents.

Gatekeeping – The Council is under pressure to reduce the number of families in temporary accommodation and the number of people recorded as homeless. This means they can give confusing advice, leaving people who are homeless thinking they cannot get housed. Only people who make a fuss or take legal action are likely to get what they need.

Proposals to introduce two-year **fixed term tenancies** for council and housing association tenants and increasing rents for new social housing tenants.
